 - a. On Sundays and other times of meeting. . . **We Gather to Scatter.** How does / can your "scattering" include leading people to Jesus?
4. What is the purpose of Biblical, Spiritual, Relational teaching?
 - a. Obedience
 - b. ACTION
5. To be a "Witness" is to be a "Martyr." What does this mean for you personally, your family, our church?
6. To be a witness requires the **power of the Holy Spirit** (Acts 1:8).
 - a. To discern where, when, to whom and how.
 - b. To overcome fear.

Pray for one another in your group for discernment for each person's unique role in leading people to Jesus, and for the power of the Holy Spirit toward being an effective witness.
