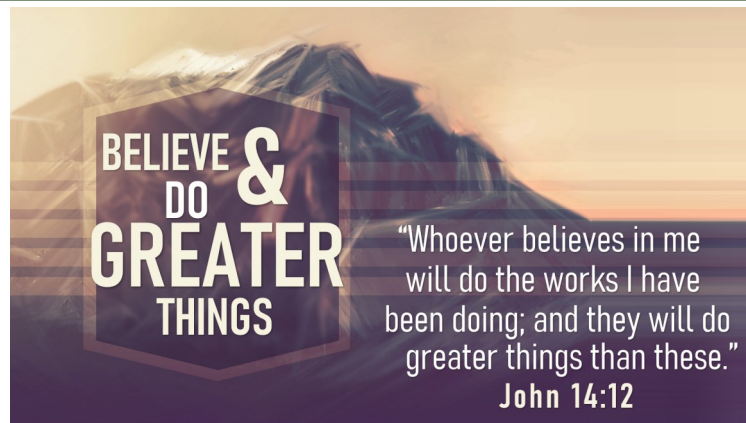

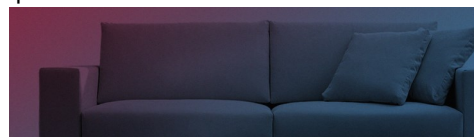

**Mondays from 6:45 PM – 8:00 PM (Starting Oct. 3)**

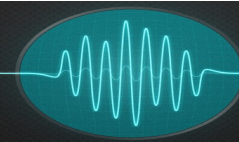
